OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY NETWORK JULY 2016 (updated)

The Ventura County SELPA Developmental Motor Skills Guidelines were originally developed by the Ventura County Occupational Therapy Network in October 2001. The purpose was to create a fine and gross motor skill assessment tool for children 0-6 years of age. The guidelines clustered skills from several instruments such as the Brigance, Vineland, HELP, VMI, and Peabody into a consensus of skills for each sequential 6-month period from birth to 6 years. The skills are listed in the approximate order of difficulty within each age period. The revised guidelines incorporate the skills from the most updated version of the former instruments. It is meant to capture the milestones of each age range while realizing that there are several other skills that are also developing at the same time.
